This is some information on the MATERNAL ancestry of Morris Williams, Betty Williams Stoltze, and Jimmy English. Take note that this is not all verified history, just what has been pulled together but it is generally accurate. Also note that there are some variations in spellings of some names.

In March, 1852, Ichabod Fouraker (Born 1823) married Nancy Daugharty (Born 1839). Apparently she was 13 years old and he was 29.

This marriage produced 14 children. Here are their names and birth years. Only first names are listed--all the last names are of course Fouraker: Nancy--1854, Aaron--1856, Nathan--1858, Sara--1861, James --1862, Giddon--1866, ELIZABETH--1868, William--1872, Martha --1872, Margaret--1874, Annie Dell--1876, Walter Ichabod (date not known), Sallie--1879. Apparently Sara, William, and Sally died at or near birth.

Elizabeth Fouraker was destined to become Grandmother to Morris, Betty, and Jimmy. It started when Elizabeth married Jesse English. They had 4 children: Ida Bell (sometimes spelled Belle) English, Lillie Mae English, Jesse Lawson English, and Willie Edgar English. Ida English had 3 children: James Malcolm English, Mary Elizabeth (Betty) Williams, and Hugh Morris Williams.

ELIZABETH FOURAKER (Ida's Mother) was born May 24, 1868, in Fargo, Clinch County, Georgia. She died March 12, 1954, in Savannah, Georgia, and was buried March 15, 1954, at Bethel Cemetery in Clinch County, Georgia.

Here is information on Elizabeth Fouraker's parents (Ida's grandparents): ICHABOD FOURAKER was born in 1823 in Valdosta, Lowndes County, Georgia. He died December 29, 1883, in Echols County, Georgia, and was buried in Fargo, Clinch County, Georgia. He married his wife Nancy in March, 1852, in Lake City, Columbia County, Florida. Ichabod's father was Jacob Yelvington and his mother's name was Nancy.

NANCY DAUGHARTY was born 1839 in Ware, Georgia, and she died May 5, 1919, in Wellborn, Suwannee County, Florida. She was buried in Fargo, Clinch, County, Georgia. Her father was James Daugherty and her mother was Nancy Bassett.

IDA BELL ENGLISH Williams was born February 16, 1891 and died November 12, 1969. Her burial service was held at 3 p.m. on November 15, 1969, at Wesleyan Hall of the First Methodist Church in Lake City, Florida, and was buried in the Bethel Methodist

Church cemetery. The minister was Rev. Dennis Delacure and arrangements were made by J. Robert Weaver Funeral Home, 423 South Marion St., Lake City, Florida.

Pallbearers were Lenvil Dicks, Doyle Cason, Robert Hancock, Thomas Matthews, Harry Spradley, and Ike Moses. To avoid confusion, take note that there is a BETHEL PRIMITIVE BAPTIST CHURCH cemetery in Georgia where many of the Fouraker family is buried. There is a BETHEL UNITED METHODIST CHURCH cemetery south of Lake City where some of the Williams family is buried.

HIS HIGHEST SALARY AS SCHOOL SUPT. WAS \$3,000 PER YEAR (\$250 PER MONTH), FROM 1943-44. HIS LAST DAY AS SCHOOL SUPT. WAS DECEMBER 31, 1944. HE BEGAN HIS RETIREMENT FROM PUBLIC EDUCATION JAN. 1, 1945.

HE REGISTERED FOR MILITARY SERVICE IN WORLD WAR I ON SEPTEMBER 18, 1918, BUT NEVER SERVED BECAUSE THE WAR ENDED.

HE GRADUATED FROM THE 'BOWLING GREEN BUSINESS UNIVERSITY' IN THE CLASS OF 1914 WITH THE DEGREE 'BACHELOR OF COMMERCIAL SCIENCE' AND HIS COURSE WORK INCLUDED TRAINING IN SHORTHAND AND BOOKKEEPING. BOWLING GREEN UNIVERSITY WAS LOCATED IN BOWLING GREEN, KENTUCKY, AND THAT UNIVERSITY IS NOW CALLED WESTERN KENTUCKY UNIVERSITY.

TEACHING CREDENTIALS: HE WAS AWARDED A 'LIFE FIRST GRADE CERTIFICATE GOOD IN ANY PART OF FLORIDA AND OF PERPETUAL VALIDITY' ON APRIL 6, 1917. BEFORE THAT, HE HAD HELD A FIRST GRADE CERTIFICATE FOR 6 YEARS. HE SCORED AN AVERAGE OF 94 ON THE TEST COVERING 13 SUBJECTS FOR THE TEACHER'S EXAM. NOTE: 'FIRST GRADE CERTIFICATE' DOES NOT REFER TO THE FIRST GRADE OF SCHOOL--IT MEANS GRADE ONE, FIRST CLASS, TOP-LEVEL, THE HIGHEST CERTIFICATE A TEACHER COULD HOLD.

HE WAS BAPTIZED 'IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER, THE SON, AND THE HOLY GHOST" ON DECEMBER 25, 1963, BY METHODIST MINISTER WALTER CROSS, WITNESSED BY HIS DAUGHTER MARJORIE WILLIAMS TYSON AND HIS BROTHER 'NEWT' WILLIAMS. HE DIED THE NEXT DAY.
